Charles A. Alutto is President and Chief Executive Officer of Stericycle, Inc. Charlie oversees the strategic direction of the \$3.6 billion services company based out of Lake Forest, Illinois. With more than 25,500 employees in the U.S. and 21 countries, Stericycle is a global leader in outsourced business-to-business services including regulated waste services; compliance training; secure information destruction; live voice and automated communication services; and product recall and retrievals.

Prior to being named CEO in January of 2013, Charlie served in several leadership roles at Stericycle. His career with the company began in 1997; Charlie had served as an Area Vice President of Sales for a company acquired by Stericycle. From there he moved into roles as Vice President of Healthcare Sales and Marketing, Vice President and Managing Director of Stericycle Europe, and President of Stericycle US Healthcare Compliance Solutions.

Before joining Stericycle, Charlie spent nine years with the New York-based Environmental Control Company. He started his career as a sales representative and progressed to Director of Sales and Marketing.

Charlie was named to the 2014 Institutional Investor Magazine All American Executive Team (ranked #3 CEO for Business, Education and Professional Services – Buy Side) and one of "75 People to Know in Chicago Healthcare" by Becker's Hospital Review.
