## NOTES/GUIDELINES:

- All students must take 12 MBA courses; 9 core courses, 3 elective courses (in addition to prerequisites if required)
- Registration and payment for MBA courses are completed electronically via Cyberfrier; SCE courses must be registered for with the SCE office
- All students must fulfill all pre-requisite/foundation courses
- Pre-requisite courses are offered as follows:
  - MBA 533: Econ. Fall
  - MBA 548: Acct. Fall
  - MBA 532: Finance Spring
  - MKT 205: Principles of Mkt. (SCE) Summer/Fall
  - MTH 108: Math for Bus. Analysis I (SCE) Summer
  - MTH 217 or FIN 217 (SCE) Spring/Summer
- MBA 700 (Capstone) requires that MBA 603, 651, 626 & 690 be completed before registration
- Core courses are typically offered each semester
- Winter and Maymester courses are typically only electives
- Part-Time: 1-2 courses per term min. and max.
- Full-Time: 3-4 courses per term min. and max.
- If a student has taken 6 or more courses in MGT, FIN, ACC, or MKT, they can choose to waive the MBA course equivalent (must be replaced by an MBA elective) (must submit a Waiver Form)
- If waived from MBA 699: Internship, this must be replaced with an additional elective
- Concentrations require three elective courses in one area of study
- Electives are offered one per semester in each area of study; electives typically repeat each academic year
