How To Prepare For Your Academic Advising Meeting

- Look at your <u>degree audit</u> in advance of meeting with your academic advisor. A degree audit breaks down all of your core and major requirements. It also contains your cumulative and major GPAs as well as other helpful information.
- Review your <u>academic planning forms</u> for your respective major and class year. These
 planning forms break down all of your degree requirements in a semester-by-semester
 format and include important prerequisite sequencing for courses.
- Check to see if you have a registration hold. You can view holds by using the MyPC app or by viewing their <u>Academic Profile</u>. Students should still plan to meet with their advisor to plan their courses, even if they are working to resolve a registration hold.
